

Angel Sense GPS Device Guidelines

- 1) Recipient family must be a member of Autism Society Acadiana.
- 2) Devices will be distributed on a “first-come, first-served” basis.
- 3) The family receiving the GPS device will be responsible for maintaining and paying for the monthly AngelSense monitoring subscription after the first three months of service.
- 4) All transactions will be handled through AngelSense and not through Autism Society of Acadiana.
- 5) If selected, the family will meet with a representative from Autism Society Acadiana to go over program and maintaining the monitoring subscription with AngelSense.
- 6) The family is strongly advised to notify the child’s school about his AngelSense GPS Device.
- 7) This form must be signed by a member of the family awarded an AngelSense GPS Device and a representative of Autism Society Acadiana.
